



This is an educational movement, one which is not in favour of extreme partisan thinking. Our goal is to contribute within the educational process which helps citizens realise, that various social and political situations are better understood in a context which is balanced and democratic, one which allows for listening.

Persons who are part of the movement do understand that before they are members of a political party, they are first and foremost Maltese democratic citizens and thus they should put the national interest and the interests of democracy first. We aim to encourage Maltese citizens to look at social and political situations in a way which is less partisan and as objective as possible.

We believe that the time has come to start a new way of doing politics. Many of us are tired of listening to partisan feuds, spins which lack objectivity, arguments which do not lead towards progress, attitudes which cause a disinterest in politics or even worse a division amongst what could & should be a united nation.

We do also believe that there are various 'themes' about which political parties can reach a consensus and when this happens this would be beneficial. Such mutual agreements about specific sectors would provide a stable roadmap which works in the long run with consistency and stability in the interest of the nation as a whole.

As part of the movement & as fully participative and active democratic citizens we do experience a sigh of relief when witnessing unanimous agreements about important themes between political parties, especially when this agreement is made public.



We believe in moderation, dialogue and the use of reason. We believe that quite a number of solutions are found in the middle ground without the need to create division about them.

We do also believe that whoever is part of the movement could be a critical citizen of any political party, precisely because he/she would not accept to get caught up within the partisan perspective that sees perfection in one party and a total flop in another.

To confirm the latter, as part of the movement we are willing to attend to activities & seminars which are organised by N.G.O's, different political parties or minority groups in order to support their causes, especially if these work in the national interest or in a progressive manner.

This movement can be an instrument which provides a type of 'political oxygen' for the Maltese islands, a new way of practicing and viewing politics. The movement can be an antidote to extreme partisan thinking - a movement which will promote political dialogue between various Maltese citizens with the aim of promoting national unity.
