



If there is a word which explains our attitude as part of the movement, it is this: the word progress. This is a movement which is particularly open to all those people who consider themselves as 'life long learners', persons who are dynamic, always ready to learn and progress and as a result are in a process of continual renewal and evolution.

This is the particular character of this movement, one which is not so common in the typical Maltese political scenario which is often dominated by extreme partisan thinking and confrontations which end up disappointing many Maltese and Gozitan citizens.



As part of the movement we prefer to look forward in a progressive manner, in a way that builds upon the progress which has already been started by previous governments.

We hope to see our country progress to the point that when the opposition (apart from criticising) also manages to provide solutions – the government acknowledges such proposals in a positive manner and publically acknowledges the source of the solution.

As part of this movement we look forward to work hand in hand with persons who are solution oriented, people who choose to pull up their sleeves and work hard to provide solutions via creativity, intelligence and innovation.

At this point we would also prefer to clarify that as part of the movement we are not campaigning for some sort of 'neutrality vacuum' which does not commit to make a choice towards a political party or another during election time.

We are simply campaigning for a more open minded attitude were even though a person chooses to support a specific political party, he/she maintains the psychological and emotional capability to enter into a balanced dialogue with persons who hold a different political position.
